The fairways and greens are improving with the gorgeous weather we are having. As fall weather approaches the course will improve and the stress on the grass will decrease. We aerated the greens on August 27 and 28. Aeration is done to get a gas exchange in the soil after a stressful summer and to promote a root system to get the turf ready for winter.

The irrigation system still has some lingering problems but for the most part, it is working fairly well.



The crew has installed a bell on the 10th hole to let golfers know they have left the green. The red and yellow tees on 8 and 11 have new ball washers. The crew has also installed new yardage signs to the par threes; yardages are to the center on the greens.

The possible fall project is the construction of a new red/yellow tee on the 14th hole. When you are playing, it is to the left of the existing tee and it has some stakes and paint around the proposed area.
